About Jay Peak

Jay Peak, with a vertical of 2,153 feet, is located in northern Vermont a few miles from the Canadian border. It has been known for its unbelievable terrain, incomparable glades, and abundant natural snowfall. It has the most snow in eastern North America, averaging 355" per year. Vermont's only aerial tramway is one of 8 lifts accessing 385 acres of terrain, including 76 trails and 4 terrain parks for skiers and riders of all abilities. Jay Peak's boundary-to-boundary woods policy makes it a favorite among advanced skiers and riders but the glades aren't for experts only. Trip Application & Agreement Form for Jay Peak March 18 to March 24, 2012

This trip is sponsored by Suburban, Erie Shore and Lewis Ski Clubs. Each individual registering for this trip via Suburban Ski Club must complete the form below. A person who is not a member of a club affiliated with CMSC must pay a membership fee and submit a membership application along with this form.

The undersigned participant applies to participate in the Jay Peak trip described herein and in the trip flier, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. **Deposits and Payments:** The required deposit for this trip is \$ 300.00 and must be paid and submitted along with this completed and signed Application and Agreement Form by November 1, 2011. The second payment of \$300.00 is due by December 1 and the final payment of \$299.00 is due on January 1, 2012. Checks should be made payable to Suburban Ski Club and mailed to Joe Sullivan; Suburban Ski Club; 2775 Derbyshire Road; Cleveland Heights, Ohio 44106.

2. **Withdrawal and Change:** The Clubs may refuse to accept or retain any person as a participant at any time for any reason; and may change the itinerary at any time. The trip price is based upon a minimum of 21 skiers and may be canceled if there are less than 21 paid skiers.

3. **Responsibility:** The Clubs are acting gratuitously for the applicant and shall not be responsible or liable for any loss of or damage to baggage, property, or for any loss, injury, death, accident, delay, inconvenience or any other loss occurring during or occasioned by applicant's participation in this Jay Peak trip, and as a result of any actual or alleged negligence of the Clubs or any ski club member or officer.

4. **Minors:** A minor must also complete an Application & Agreement Form. This form must be co-signed by his/her parent or legal guardian. The minor must be accompanied on the trip by a parent or legal guardian, or their designee, who shall be wholly and fully responsible for said minor's conduct and well being.

5. Cancellation & Refunds:

A) Cancellation by registrant means and includes: failure to abide by the terms of this agreement, notice by registrant of intent to cancel; registrant's failure to make timely payments; registrant's failure for any reason to meet the departure or return times of the trip.

B) Where Suburban Ski Club cancels or withdraws this trip, the registrant shall be entitled to a full refund unless such cancellation or withdrawal is necessitated or caused, in whole or in part, by registrant's cancellation or failure to make timely payments.

C) Where participant cancels on or before December 15, 2011, registrant shall be responsible for a cancellation service charge of not less than \$25.00.

D) In addition, where registrant cancels after December 15, 2011 and where the trip departs full (21 or more skiers) or where registrant provides an immediate replacement, who completes this agreement, then registrant shall receive a full refund less the cancellation service charge. However, if the trip departs less than full and registrant has not provided a replacement, then registrant may be entitled only to a refund taking into account any amounts paid by The Clubs for registrant's unused transportation, lodging, meals, lifts, or amenities and less the cancellation service charge. The amount of the refund, if any, is at the sole discretion of Suburban Ski Club.

6. **Eligibility:** Participation in this trip is available to members of ski clubs affiliated with the Cleveland Metro Ski Council. Those who are not members of such a club must fill out a SSC membership application and pay the membership fee.
