Dear Suburban Ski Club Members,

Despite all the uncertainty that the ongoing pandemic has brought (and continues to bring) to planning for the season, the Executive Board has remained hard at work to ensure that we have the best season possible given the circumstances.

The Board plans to have a Zoom meeting on Thursday, November 5th, to make sure we have the latest updated information regarding Telluride, the Eastern Trip, and the one and two-day trips, which we plan to share with everyone at our next membership meeting on the following **Thursday, November 12th, via Zoom**. We also plan to hold another Zoom meeting, sometime between the November 5th Board meeting and the November 12th membership meeting for those signed up for, or may be interested in, the Telluride trip. **Beth Silverman** has finally obtained detailed cost information for possibly changing the trip from the current January 9 – 16 dates to several optional weeks in March, which most, if not all, believe is a good idea given COVID. Also, the cost differentials for making such a change appear to be smaller than originally thought, and, in fact, for some of the weeks being considered, the costs are actually a bit lower. According to Beth, we need to vote on and decide this issue by November 15th. So, once the Telluride options are

discussed by the EB, I will notify everyone immediately and provide Zoom information for the special meeting about Telluride.
