

SSC'S BUS TRIPS FOR 2024

Hello SSC Members,

We have five fun-filled day trips planned for 2024! Four are available to all SSC members while one is a special "ladies only" trip for new members. Please see the details found in the <u>Master Ski Schedule for 2024 printed on page 6.</u>

Two of our bus trips will be on a **full-size bus to Holiday Valley** with the Lewis Ski Club. They will be on Fridays (January 12 and February 9), and we will stop in Ellicottville for dinner before we head back home. A morning snack will be provided on the bus.

Pick up and drop off locations for these combined trips with Lewis will be: Westside – Home Depot, Brook Park Eastside – Holiday Inn, Mayfield Village Far Eastside – Best Friends Restaurant, Geneva (Exit #18 on I90)

We will also be running **two additional day trips on a unique smaller bus** for SSC members only. These trips will be on Wednesdays. On January 31st we will go to Peek 'n Peak and on February 28th we travel to Holiday Valley. This smaller bus accommodates a maximum of twenty-eight people, and it is our attempt to have a trip for SSC members without the risk of having to fill a large bus.

Pick up and drop off locations for the smaller bus will be: Westside – Lakewood Park, Lakewood Eastside – Holiday Inn, Mayfield Village Far Eastside – Best Friends Restaurant, Geneva (Exit #18 on I90)
